There will be a **General Parish Membership Meeting** on Sunday, January 8, 2017. We will be electing Parish Council members and discussing important needs of our parish community.



Ephesians 2:14-22

Brethren: Christ is our peace. He it is who has made both Jews and Gentiles one, and has broken down the intervening wall of the enclosure, the enemy, in His flesh. He has voided the Law of commandments expressed in decrees, so that of the two He might create in Himself one new man, and make peace, and reconcile both in one body to God through the Cross, having destroyed their enmity within Himself. And as He came, He announced the good tidings of peace to you who were far away, and of peace to those who were near: because through Him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. Therefore, you are now no longer strangers or foreigners, but citizens with the saints and members of God's household: you are built upon the foundation of the Apostles and Prophets with Christ Himself as the chief cornerstone. In Him the whole structure is closely fitted together and grows into a temple holy in the LORD; in Him you too are being built together into a dwelling place for God in the Spirit.

Luke 17:12-19

At that time, as Jesus was entering a certain village, there met Him ten lepers, who stood far off and lifted up their voice, crying, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" And when He saw them He said, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And it happened, as they were on their way, that they were made clean. But one of them, seeing that he was made clean, returned, with a loud voice glorifying God, and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks; and he was a Samaritan. But Jesus spoke to him and said, "Were not the ten made clean? But where are the nine? Has no one been found to return and give glory to God except this foreigner?" And He said to Him, "Arise, go on your way, for your faith has saved you."

Efesianëve 2:14-22

Vëllezër: Krishti është pagja jonë, ai që i bëri të dyja një, dhe rrëzoi murin ndërmjetës të ndarjes, duke shfuqizuar në trupin e tij armiqësinë, ligjin e porosive urdhëruese, që të ndërtojë në veten e tij nga të dy një njeri të ri, duke bërë pajtim, dhe të dy në një trup t'i pajtojë me Perëndinë me anë të kryqit, pasi vrau armigësinë në të. Edhe erdhi e predikoi ungjillin e paqes tek ju që ishit larg, dhe tek ata që ishin afër, sepse me anë të tij që të dy afrohemi në një Shpirt tek Ati. Prandaj nuk jeni më të huaj e të jashtëm, bashkëqytetarë të shenjtorëve dhe pjesëtarë të shtëpisë së Perëndisë; sepse u ndërtuat mbi themelin e apostujve e të profetëve, ku qur qosheje është vetë Jisu Krishti, në të cilin e gjithë ndërtesa e lidhur bashkë rritet në tempull të shenjtë në ZOTIN, në të cilin edhe ju jeni ndërtuar që të bëhet banesë e Perëndisë me anë të Shpirtit.

Llukait 17:12-19

Në atë kohë, kur po hynte Jisui në një fshat, takuan me të dhjetë burra leprozë, të cilët qëndruan nga larg. Edhe ata ngritën zërin, duke thënë: "Jisu, Mjeshtër, përdëllena". Edhe ai kur i pa, u tha atyre: "Shkoni e rrëfeni veten tuaj tek priftërinjtë". Edhe ata duke shkuar u pastruan. Edhe një nga ata, kur pa se u shërua, u kthye duke lavdëruar Perëndinë me zë të madh, edhe ra përmbys në këmbët e tij, dhe e falënderoi; dhe ai ishte Samaritan. Edhe Jisui u përgjigj e tha: "A nuk u pastruan të dhjetët? Po të nëntët ku janë? Nuk u gjendën të tjerë të kthehen që t'i japin lavdi Perëndisë, veç ky prej tjetër kombi?" Edhe i tha: "Ngrihu, e shko; besimi yt të shpëtoi."
