2 Corinthians 4:6-15

Brethren, God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, has shone in our hearts, to give enlightenment concerning the knowledge of God's glory, shining in Christ Jesus' face. But we carry this treasure in vessels of clay, to show that its superabundant power is God's, and not ours. In all things we suffer tribulation but we are not distressed, we are sorely pressed but we are not destitute, we endure persecution but we are not forsaken, we are cast down but we do not perish: always carrying around in our body the dying of Jesus, so that the life also of Jesus may be made manifest in our bodily frame. For we, the living, are constantly being handed over to death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus may be made manifest in our mortal flesh. Thus death is at work in us, but life in you. But since we have the same spirit of faith, as shown in that which is written, "I believed, and so I spoke," we also believed, wherefore we also speak. For we know that the One who raised up the LORD Jesus will raise us up also together with Jesus, and will place us with you. For all things are for your sakes, so that the grace that abounds through the many may cause thanksgiving to abound for God's glory.

Luke 6:31-36

The LORD said, "Even as you wish men to do to you, so also do you to them. And if you love those who love you, what merit have you? For even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what merit have you? For even sinners do that. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive in return, what merit have you? For even sinners lend to sinners that they may get back as much in return. But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, not hoping for any return, and your reward shall be great, and you shall be children of the Most High, for He is kind towards the ungrateful and evil. Be merciful, therefore, even as your Father is merciful."

2 Korinthianëve 4:6-15

Në çdo gjë shtrëngohemi, po nuk jemi në ngush-ticë; jemi të ngatërruar, po nuk dëshpërohemi; ndiqemi, po nuk jemi të braktisur nga Perëndia; jemi të mposhtur, po jo të humbur, duke sjellë përreth gjithmonë në trupin tonë vdekjen e ZOTIT Jisu, që edhe jeta e Jisuit të shfaqet në trupin tonë. Sepse ne që rrojmë gjithnjë jepemi në vdekje për Krishtin, që edhe jeta e Jisuit të shfaqet në trupin tonë të vdekshëm. Kështu vdekja vepron mbi ne, dhe jeta mbi ju. Edhe duke pasur po atë shpirt besimi, sipas shkrimit "Besova, prandaj fola," edhe ne besojmë, prandaj edhe flasim, duke ditur se ai që ngjalli ZOTIN Jisu do të na ngjallë edhe ne me anë të Jisuit, dhe do të na nxjerrë përpara tij bashkë me ju. Sepse të gjitha janë për ju, që hiri, duke tepruar për falënderimin e më të shumtëve, të teprorë në lavdinë e Perëndisë.

Llukai 6:31-36

ZOTI tha: "Siç doni t'ju bëjnë juve njerëzit, edhe ju bëjuni atyre po ashtu. Edhe në daçi ata që ju duan, çfarë hiri keni ju? Sepse edhe mëkatarët duan ata që i duan. Edhe në u bëfshi mirë atyre që ju bëjnë mirë juve, çfarë hiri keni ju? Sepse edhe mëkatarët po atë bëjnë. Edhe nëse u jepni hua atyre, prej të cilëve shpresoni t'i merrni prapë, çfarë hiri keni ju? Sepse edhe mëkatarët u japin hua mëkatarëve, që t'i marrin prapë një nga një. Por duajini armiq të tuaj, dhe bëni mirë, dhe jepni hua, pa pasur ndonjë shpresë më; dhe atëherë paga juaj do të jetë e shumtë, dhe do të jeni bijtë e të Lartit; sepse ai është i mirë me ata që nuk ia njohin të mirën dhe me të këqijtë. Bëhuni pra përdëllimtarë, sikurse dhe ati juaj është përdëllimtar."
