Today's Scripture Readings

1 Corinthians 8:8-9:2

Brethren, food does not commend us to God. For neither shall we gain any advantage if we eat, nor suffer any loss if we do not. And yet, beware lest perhaps this right of yours become a stumblingblock to the weak. For if a man sees you who "have knowledge" sitting at table in a place dedicated to idols, will not his conscience, weak as it is, be emboldened to eat idol offerings? And through your "knowledge" the weak one will perish, the brother for whom Christ died. Now, when you sin in this way against the brethren and wound their weak conscience, you are sinning against Christ. Therefore if food scandalizes my brother, I will never again eat any more meat so as not to scandalize my brother. Am I not an Apostle? Am I not free? Have I not seen Jesus our LORD? Are you not my work in the LORD? And if to others I am not an Apostle, yet to you I am. For you are the seal set upon my Apostleship in the LORD.

Matthew 25:31-46

The LORD said, "At that time when the Son of Man shall come in His majesty, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory; and before Him will be gathered all the nations, and He will separate them one from another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; and He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to

those on His right hand, 'Come, blessed of my Father, take possession of the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you have me to eat; I was thirsty and you gave me to drink; I was a stranger and you took me in; naked and you covered me; sick and you visited me; I was in prison and you came to me.' Then the just will answer Him, saying, 'LORD, when did we see You hungry, and feed You; or thirsty, and give You to drink? And when did we see You a stranger, and take You in; or naked, and clothe You? Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' And answering, the King will say to them, 'Amen I say to you, every time you did it for one of these, the least of my brethren, you did it for me.' Then He will say to those on His left hand, 'Go away from me, accursed ones, into the everlasting fire which was prepared for the devil and his ministers. For I was hungry, and you did not give me to eat; I was thirsty and you gave me no drink; I was a stranger and you did not take me in; naked, and you did not clothe me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit me.' Then they also will answer and say, 'LORD, when did we see You hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not take care of You?' Then He will answer them, saying, 'Amen I say to you, as long as you did not do it for one of these least ones, you did not do it for me.' And these will go into everlasting punishment, but the just into everlasting life."

Leximi për sot nga Shkrimit të Shenjtë

1 Korinthianëve 8:8-9:2

Vëllezër, po të ngrënët nuk na afron tek Perëndia; sepse edhe sikur të hamë, nuk do të kemi gjë më shumë; as sikur të mos hamë, nuk do të kemi gjë më pak. Po shikoni se mos pushteti juaj bëhet pengesë për të dobëtit. Sepse në të paftë ndonjë ty që ke dituri, se rri në tryezë në tempull idhujsh, ndërgjegja e atij që është i dobët, a nuk do të marrë guxim të hajë therorët e idhujve? Edhe kështu për diturinë tënde do të humbasë vëllai i dobët, për të cilin Krishti vdiq. Edhe kur mëkatoni ndaj vëllezërive, dhe kështu plagosni ndërgjegjen e tyre të dobët, në Krishtin keni mëkatuar. Prandaj në qoftë se ngrënia ime skandalizon tim vëlla, s'kam për të ngrënë mish për gjithë jetën, që të mos skandalizoj tim vëlla. A nuk jam apostull? A nuk jam i lirë? A nuk e pashë unë Jisu Krishtin, ZOTIN tonë? Në mos jam apostull mbi të tjerë, po së paku mbi ju jam; sepse në ZOTIN vula e apostolisë sime jeni ju.

Matheut 25:31-46

ZOTI u tha: "Kur të vijë Biri i njeriut në lavdinë e tij, dhe gjithë engjëjt e shenjtë bashkë me të, atëherë do të rrijë mbi fronin e lavdisë së tij. Edhe do të mblidhen përpara tij gjithë kombet; dhe do t'i ndajë ata njërin nga tjetri, siç ndan bariu dhentë nga kecat. Edhe do të vërë dhentë në të djathtë dhe kecat në të majtë. Atëherë mbreti do t'u thotë atyre që rrinë në të djathtë të tij: 'Ejani të bekuarit e tim. Eti, trashëgoni mbretërinë që

është bërë gati për ju që kur se është themeluar bota. Sepse pata uri e më dhatë të ha; pata etje, e më dhatë të pi; i huaj isha, e më morët në shtëpi; i zhveshur, e më veshët; u sëmura, dhe erdhët të më shihni; isha në burg, dhe erdhët tek unë.' Atëherë të drejtët do t'i përgjigjen, duke thënë: 'Zot, kur të pamë ty duke pasur uri e të ushqyem? Apo duke pasur etje, e të dhamë të pish? Edhe kur të pamë të huaj, e të morëm nëpër shtëpira? Apo të zhveshur, e të veshëm? Edhe kur të pamë të sëmurë ose në burg, dhe erdhëm tek ti?' Edhe mbreti do të përgjigjet e do t'u thotë atyre: 'Me të vërtetë po ju them juve, gjithë sa i bëtë njërit prej këtyre vëllezërve të mi më të vegjël, ma keni bërë mua.' Atëherë do t'u thotë edhe atyre që rrinë në të majtë: 'Ikni prej meje, të mallkuar, në zjarr të pasosur, që është bërë gati për djallin e për engjëjt e tij. Sepse pata uri, e s'më dhatë të ha; pata etje, e s'më dhatë të pi; isha i huaj, e nuk më morët brenda; i zhveshur, dhe nuk më veshët; i sëmurë e në burg, dhe nuk erdhët të më shihni.' Atëherë do t'i përgjigjen edhe ata, duke thënë: 'Zot, kur të pamë ty duke pasur uri, a duke pasur etje, a të huaj, a të zhveshur, a të sëmurë, a në burg, e nuk të shërbyem?' Atëherë do t'u përgjigjet e do t'u thotë atyre: 'Me të vërtetë po ju them juve, gjithë sa nuk i bëtë njërit prej këtyre më të vegjëlve, as mua nuk ma keni bërë.' Edhe këta do të shkojnë në mundim të përjetshëm; dhe të drejtët në jetë të përjetshme."
